Coventry is a day program that provides life enrichment opportunities for adults with special needs when they no longer qualify for public school programs. Coventry’s program promotes engaged and creative learning and is structured to address mental, physical, social, emotional and spiritual needs. Our low staff to participant ratio supports a safe and happy atmosphere. We believe every person is valuable and deserving of dignity and respect. With appropriate assistance and loving guidance, all are capable of enjoying a full, active and purposeful life.

To create a beautiful Christ-centered community where adults with special needs can experience a full, active and purposeful life.

Our History & Future

In 2002, a small group of parents began serving three adults in a private home. The goal was simple: a place to continue learning and making friends in a safe and cheerful environment. Pursuance of our vision has been continuous and steady. We moved to our current beautiful country setting in 2005.

In 2009, the property and building were purchased and in 2014 we expanded capacity again with a multi-purpose Life Enrichment Center. A sense of order and peace permeate our program, facilities and gardens. Our plans for the future include progressing our current programs and adding culinary classes.

Considering the needs and desires of our families, we also anticipate establishing respite and residential options.



Our Program

Coventry is different. Our small group model is designed to encourage teamwork and support individuals as they stretch beyond perceived limitations. In the Brain Building Center, therapeutic activities build flexibility, attention and integrate sensory pathways. Using those abilities and simplified steps, our participants create beautiful handcrafted pottery and art in the Creative Skills Center. Horticulture classes teach scientific concepts with opportunities for hands on experience. Daily large group teaching and adapted fitness enrich a balanced day. Our program provides essential structure through repetition while maintaining interest through variety.

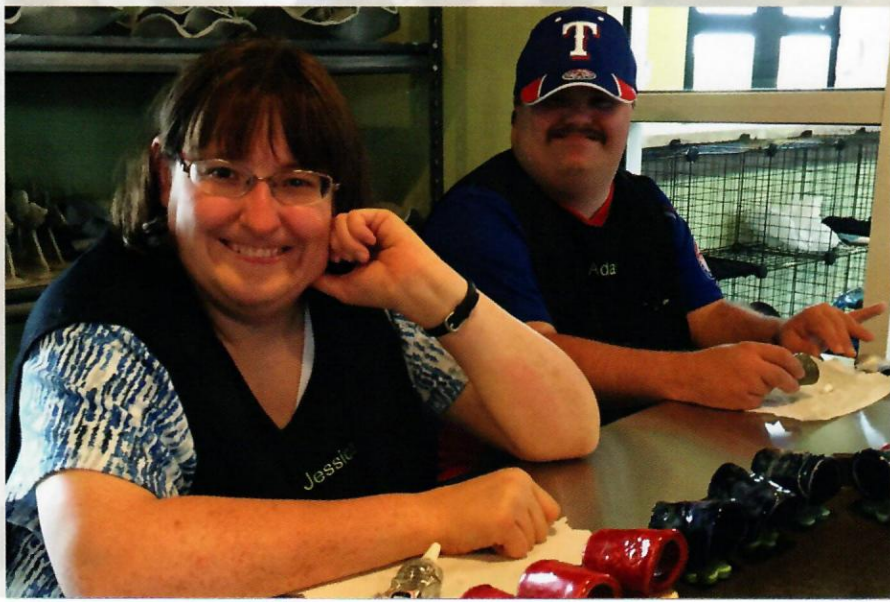


Volunteers, Sponsors, and Friends
