Who does Daymark serve?

Daymark was created for individuals 18+ with intellectual and developmental disabilities like Down syndrome, autism, cerebral palsy, Cornelia De Lange, TBIs, Williams Syndrome, Penta X, and more. Currently, our youngest resident is 19, and our oldest is 65.

Potential residents must be independent in their basic daily living skills like showering, dressing, and following a schedule with the help of staff's prompting and reminders. We understand that residents won't be perfect at these skills, and are prepared to help them grow!

What does a typical day look like?

At Daymark, your loved one's day is tailored to suit them! We understand that every resident has unique needs to meet and goals to achieve, so we take a multifaceted approach to instruction, individual coaching, and group activities, focusing on six key areas:

- Occupational
- Physical
- Social
- Intellectual
- Spiritual
- Emotional

Outside of class, residents can enjoy our resort-style pool, game room, movie theatre, walking trail, fitness center, volleyball/sports court, interest clubs, daily off-campus activities, and so much more!

Do you help residents find a job?

While we cannot promise your loved one an off-campus job, meaningful employment is a huge focus of our program. If a resident is interested in working, our Career Development and Job Coaching course will prepare them for work through career exploration, mock interviews, and more. We are also in the process of hiring a Best Buddies job coach to serve Daymark's residents.

Is there transportation?

Yes, we offer scheduled transportation to and from local employers, shopping, errands, and planned group outings. Individualized transportation can be arranged for an additional cost.

How is Daymark staffed?
