\* High School students will join trip guides from Asbury's Adventure Leadership Program for a fun day of canoeing on the Dix River. Ten minutes from Asbury's campus, the Dix is one of the jewels of Central Kentucky. Paddle under historic High Bridge in a canoe and join with the tail waters of Harrington Lake in a 200-foot-deep gorge with striking limestone palisades and cool clear water. A little touch of wilderness near to home, you can expect to see waterfowl, beaver, trout and other aquatic wildlife on the trip. Trip leaders are certified Wilderness First Responders and have canoe instruction and field experience in a variety of wilderness programming. Appropriate clothing includes athletic shoes, shorts, t-shirt and swimsuit (if you would like to swim). Please also bring a towel. *Adventure Program Permission slip signed by parent is required to participate.*
