Feeding New York State leads the work to end hunger by:

Providing support to ten food banks of NYS with statewide grants and sourcing nutritious food through farmer and industry partners

Building relationships and access models with NYS farmers, growers, wholesalers & retailers to secure wholesome foods.

Advocacy outreach of working with elected officials on addressing food policies while educating the public on hunger issues

Partnering with anti-hunger organizations to ensure every community in New York state has access to good, healthy food.



FNYS Programs

- **Advocacy**- working with the Advocacy Committee of board and members to develop Federal & State Priorities
- **Food Sourcing**- acquisition of wholesome foods (produce) to support the inventories of our members while building connections with NYS farmers & growers
- **Food Recovery**- acquisition of edible foods through a large network of food generators to support the NYSDEC Food Scraps & Food Donation Law
- **Special Initiatives**-
 1. Dairy- increasing access to dairy through capacity building and investments into purchasing dairy products (FANO Boundless)
 2. Venison- acquisition of donated protein through a subsidy program to cover the costs of processing
