


O1 WHO ARE WE?

In 1990, Coloradans voted to allow limited-stakes gaming in Black Hawk, Central City, and Cripple Creek with a portion of gaming tax revenue to be redistributed in grants to preserve Colorado's historic sites. This grant program is called the State Historical Fund (SHF), a program of History Colorado. Since its inception, SHF has awarded more than 4,400 grants in all 64 counties totaling more than \$290 million.



O2 WHO CAN APPLY?



Public entities and nonprofit organizations can apply for SHF grant funding. Privately owned properties may be eligible for funding if a nonprofit organization or public entity partners to serve as the grant applicant and the project has public benefit.

*For all Acquisition and Development grants historic properties must be designated through a local landmarking program or listed in the National Register of Historic Places or State Register of Historic Properties to be considered for SHF grants. For other project types please consult SHF staff.


O3 WHAT TYPE OF PROJECTS DO WE FUND?

SHF grant projects are awarded for the preservation, rehabilitation, and restoration of historic landscapes, buildings, structures, objects, and sites. Grants are also awarded for historic preservation and archaeology educational programs, survey and planning projects, interpretation of historic sites, and archaeological analysis. Most public /non-profit projects require a 25% cash match. For projects that involve a privately held resource there is a 50% cash match requirement.
