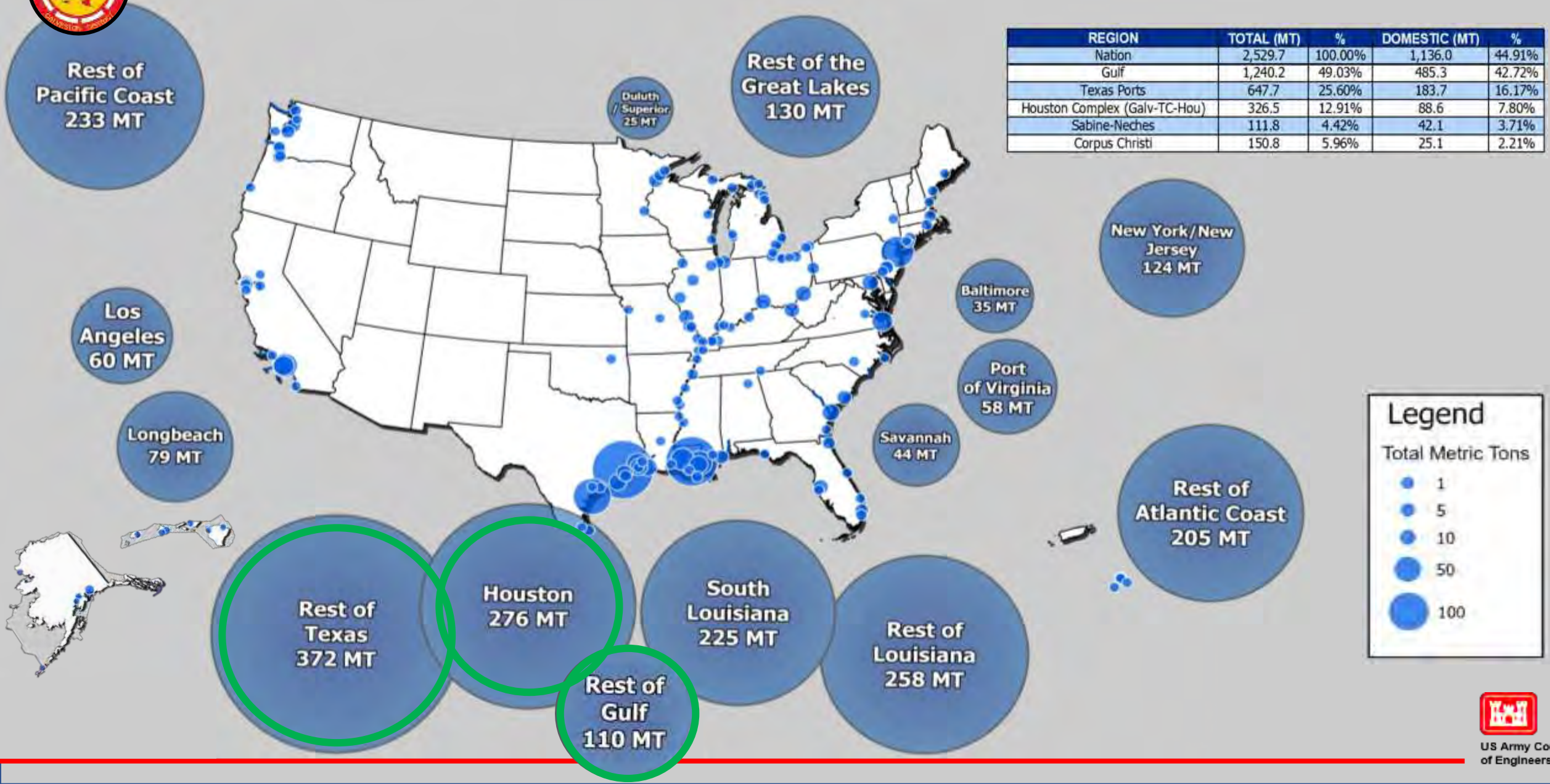

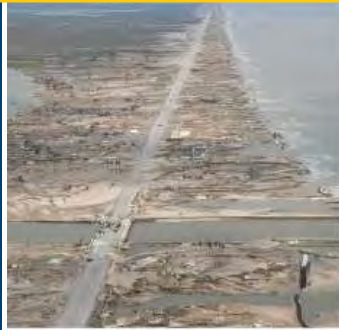

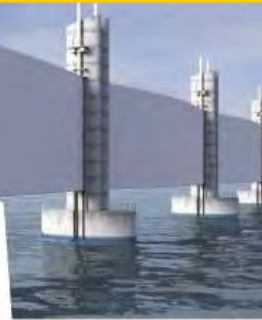

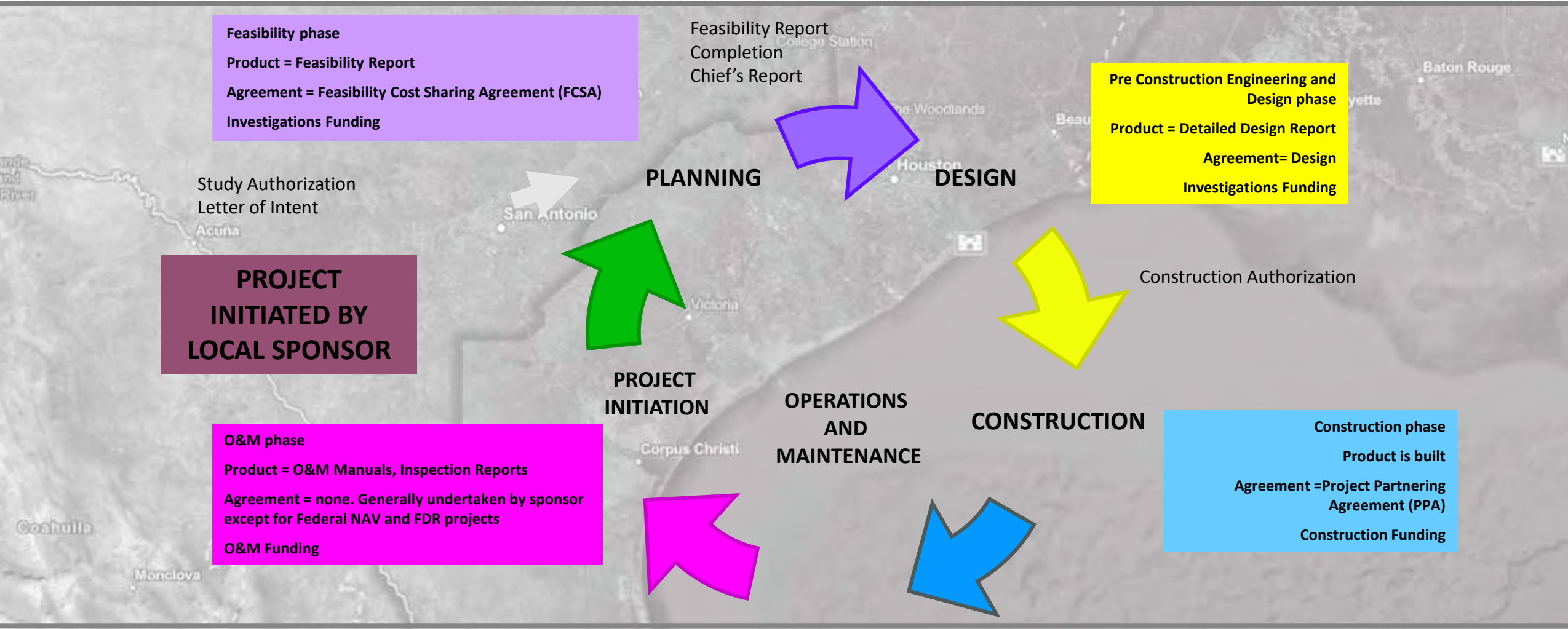

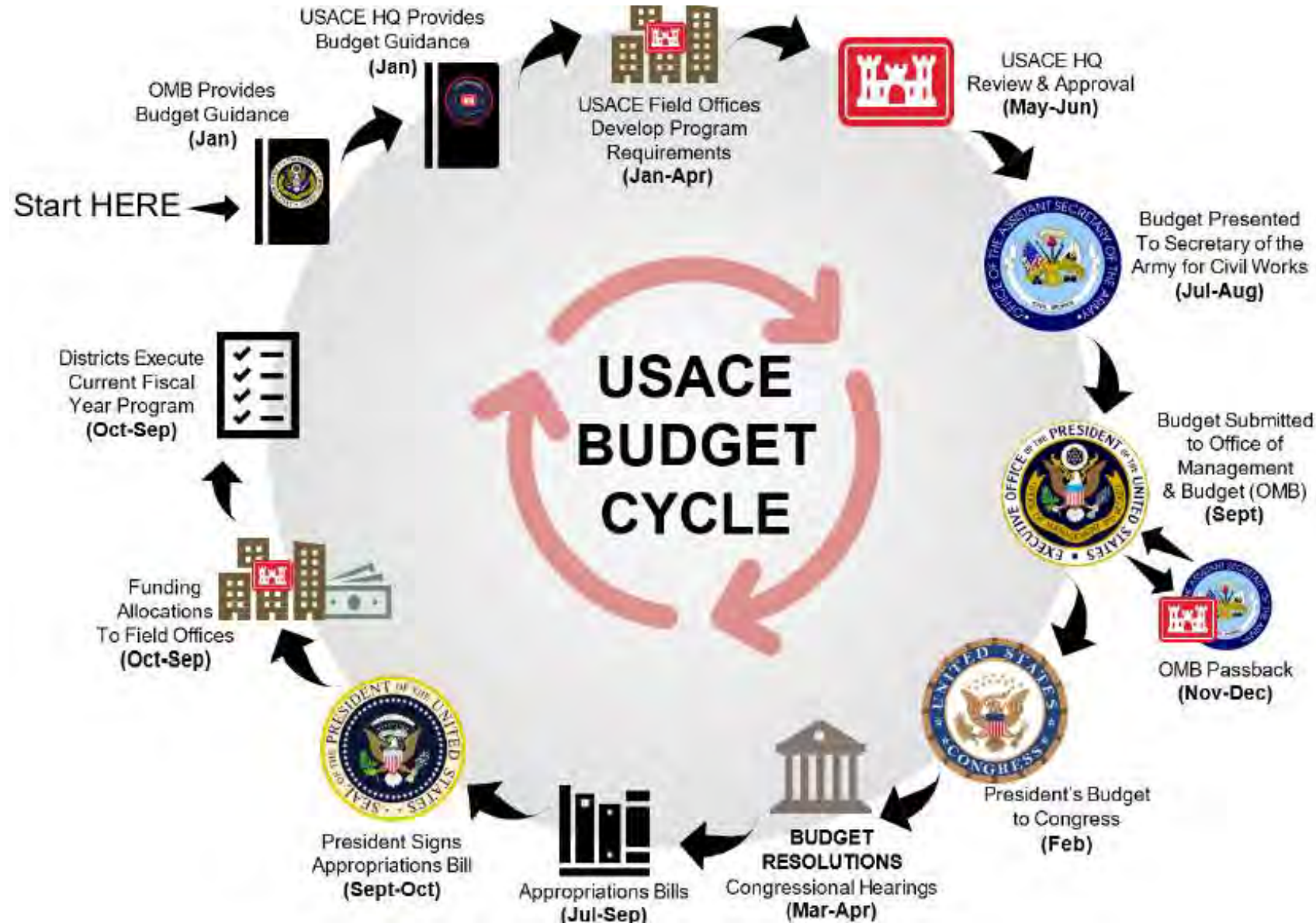


USACE Galveston District – Civil Works Project Cycle





USACE Galveston District – Program Development Timeline





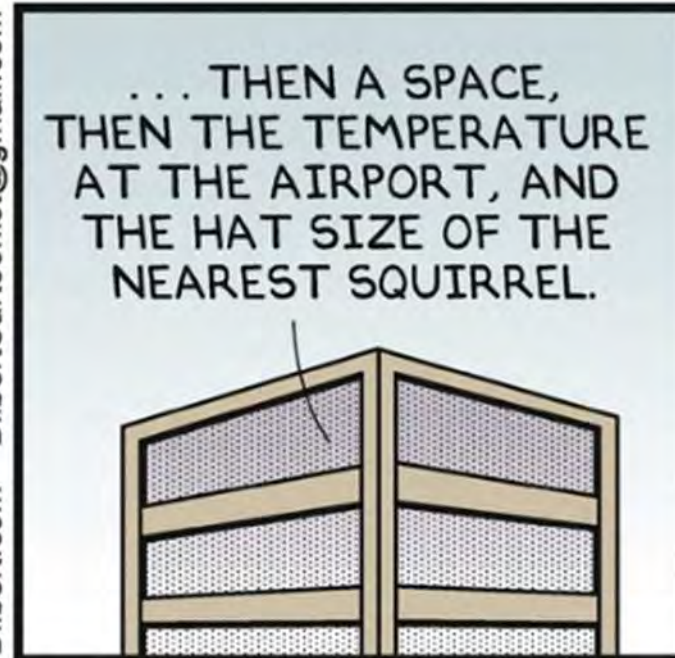
