"To Advocate" is to plead another's cause, to speak or write in support of someone.

According to National PTA, "PTA Advocacy means supporting and speaking up for students in schools, in communities, and before governing bodies and other decision-makers of policies or practices affecting students."

1. Identify a Legislative/Advocacy Vice President



- The primary responsibility of a local PTA legislative or advocacy vice president is to keep advocacy at the forefront of the discussion
- Advocacy should be on the agenda
- Represent your local PTA at school board meetings, SCC Meetings, Utah PTA Legislative Advocacy Committee, etc.







- Meet with your principal
- Learn about your school *Teacher and Student Success Plan* and the *Land Trust Plan* created by the school community council










What is PTA's legacy?
