Article X, Section 2. The executive committee shall create such commissions as may be deemed necessary to promote the Purposes and carry on the work of this PTA/PTSA.

Section 3. \_\_\_\_ (number) commissioners (in PTSAs at least one shall be a student) shall be \_\_\_\_ (appointed by the officers of this PTA/PTSA - OR - elected by its general membership). The term of each commissioner shall be one year or until the selection of his successor.

#### Article X

Section 5. The executive committee may create such special committees as it or this PTA/PTSA may deem necessary to promote the Purposes and carry on the work of this PTA/PTSA.

Section 6. Inasmuch as a special committee is created for a specific purpose, it automatically goes out of existence when its work is done and its final report is received by the executive committee.





## Required Committees



Article VII, Section 6. The books of the Treasurer shall be reconciled annually by an auditor or an <u>AFR committee</u> of not fewer than three (3) members, who, satisfied that the treasury accounts are correct, shall sign a statement of that fact.

Article VI, Section 5, a. The <u>nominating</u> <u>committee</u>, which shall nominate an eligible person for each office for which elections are to be held, shall be elected by the membership of this PTA/PTSA at a general membership meeting prior to December 31.

## The Hierarchy of PTA





National → State → Region → Council → Local

ARTICLE XI: Council Membership (Applies only to Local PTAs and PTSAs holding membership in a Council and must correspond to Council Bylaws.)

Section 1. This PTA/PTSA shall be represented on the voting body of the

\_\_\_\_\_\_Council of PTAs/PTSAs by the President or his alternate and the President-elect or his alternate (An alternate is selected from among their Local PTA/PTSA board.) and the principal or his representative.

Section 2. This PTA/PTSA shall pay annual Council dues of \_\_\_\_\_\_ per Local member, as provided in the Council Bylaws.
