



Mr. Jason E Cosby, P.E.

Mr. Jason E. Cosby is the Chief of the Facility, Sustainment, Restoration, and Modernization Execution Branch for the Air Force Civil Engineer Center (AFCEC). He plans, organizes, and directs the activities of the CONUS execution branch, ensuring compliance with legal and regulatory requirements and meeting customer needs. Directs and coordinates U. S. Air Force (USAF) facilities design and construction programs for USAF major commands (MAJCOMs), combatant, unified commands located on USAF installations, and joint base installations with a total portfolio of \$2.35B. Previously, he was the Engineering Flight Chief of the 375th Civil Engineering Squadron at Scott Air Force Base, Illinois. He oversaw construction, maintenance, and sustainment activities for 826 facilities covering over 3,400 thousand acres of infrastructure supporting U.S. Transportation Command, Air Mobility Command, 18th Air Force, 375th Air Mobility Wing, 36 mission partners, and other tenant units.

Before assuming his current position, Mr. Cosby attended Air War College in residence. He was earlier the Division Chief Engineer for the United States Forces Japan (PACOM), Director of Public Works (DPW), Assistant DPW/City Engineer, Consultant Civil-Architectural Engineer/Planner, and Transportation Planner/Engineer at the 1996 Olympic Games. During his prior experience, he was responsible for managing and implementing numerous programs designed to sustain and improve the city's physical and environmental quality. Also, during his public, private, and municipal government employment, Mr. Cosby directed over 15 different business areas, including water and wastewater, storm-water management, sanitation/residential waste management, roadways, municipal building maintenance, city real estate, city fleet management, highways, and operations, traffic/coastal engineering, planning, and overseeing construction and development with a total staff size of just under 1,500 members and budgets over \$200M, \$.5B in capital operations.
