




Anger: A strong feeling of annoyance, displeasure or hostility


- Workplace Violence: Manifestation of Anger
- Anger Happens
 - At Home At Play At the Ballgame At Work
- Justice Potter Stewart SCOTUS
 - Nico Jocobellis v. Ohio (1964)
 - The Lovers (Les Amants) by Louis Malle 1958
 - I know **it** when I see **it** and the motion picture involved in this case is not that

Did you know?


- 2020 2,654,700 OSHA Recordable Injuries: 1/12 seconds
- 2020 1,176,300 Days Away from Work (44%): 1/27 seconds
- 2020 4,764 Fatalities: 13/day
 - 37% Transportation
 - 17% Falls (STF & FFE)
 - 15% Contact With (Struck By/Against, CIB)
 - 14.7 % WPV: 1.9/day



More Did you Know? WPV – A Clear & Present Danger

- 2,000,000 Experience Some Form of WPV Annually
- 1 in 7 Don't Feel Safe in the Workplace
- 7% of Workplace Fatalities are a Result of Hitting, Kicking, Beating or Pushing
- 94% of Americans claim to have been Bullied in the Workplace

- WPV Deaths for Men 75% Higher than Women
- Most Company Safety Plans Don't Contemplate WPV



WHY? Why is WPV Seemingly on the Rise?


- Examples From Your Work Place?
- Statistically Workplace Accidents have Declined
- Between 1992-2019: 18,000
 Employees were Killed in Workplace Violence
 - If it bleeds it leads...
- Why is it that violence seems to be the answer regardless of the question?

- Violence is now Acceptable
 - We see it everyday
 - We play it everyday
 - We accept it everyday
 - Chicago, New York, LA, DC...
 - Monkey See Monkey Do
- Political Opponents are now Fascist, Communist, Anti-Semites, Racist, Right Wingers, Left Wingers, Threats to Democracy...

Workplace Violence – Four Broad Categories



Workplace Violence — *IT* (I'll Know IT when I see IT) Words to War — Rhetoric to Rampage

- What is IT?
 - Physical Assault
 - Near Misses
 - Verbal Abuse
 - Sexual Harassment
- Result of IT?
 - Physical Injury/Death
 - Fractured Relationships
 - Potential Public Relations Nightmare (Audio/Video)
 - PTSD Post Traumatic Stress Disorder
- What Causes IT & How do we Stop IT Once IT Gets Started?

 - Edmond, OK (*Any-Town USA*)
 - August 20, 1986 7:00am
 - 14 Killed & 6 Wounded
 - Paul Michael Rockne 33
- Larry Jasion & Mark Hilbun
 - Dearborn, MI & Dana Point, CA
 - May 6, 1993 9:00am & 1:00pm
 - 2 Killed & 5 Wounded

- Kenneth Tornes
 - Jackson, MS
 - April 25, 1996 9:00am
 - 4 Killed & 1 Wounded + his Wife
- Mark Orrin Barton
 - Stockbridge, GA
 - July 29, 1999
 - 9 Killed + his Wife, Mother-In-Law
 & 2 Children

All 5 of these and a host of others have one thing in common.

Day or days before the employee received some sort of performance assessment.

 - 6 Killed + the Shooter
- FedEx Memphis, TN
 - Former Employee Shot Employee
- Arby's Oklahoma City
 - Argument *I'm getting my gun...*
- Hyundai Dealership Slidell, LA
 - Shot & Killed Coworker

- Morgan Stanley Oklahoma City
 - Walked in Shot & Killed Employee
- Wendy's Prescott Valley, AZ
 - Employee HIT by a Customer
- General Mills Covington, GA
 - Shot & Killed Coworker
- Little Caesars Cincinnati, OH
 - Fired Employee Killed Manager

California Senate Bill 553?

Regulation: ALL Employers SHALL Adopt a Workplace Violence Prevention Plan

- Smart Guy
 - Math, Physics, Astronomy, Chemistry, Theology...
 - Apple Tree Dude
- 3 Laws of Motion in Physics
 - Body at Rest or in Motion will Stay at Rest or in Motion UNLESS Acted Upon by an Outside Force
 - Force = Mass X Acceleration: F = ma
 - For Every Action There is an **Equal** and **Opposite** Reaction

Ford-Steering Wheel-Four Wheels-Engine-Two Doors-Hatchback-Stick Shift-Headlights...

- Ford Pinto
 - 0-60 MPH 12.2 Seconds



- Ford Mustang Shelby GT500
 - 0-60 MPH 3.5 Seconds



These two Vehicles Have A LOT in Common! They Do NOT Have Equal Reactions! Rhetoric to Rampage in 12.2 Seconds or 3.5 Seconds?

Why not Vilo-Meters?



A meter that measures tension/anger at any given moment.

An alert system whereby we can slow the progression.

An alarm that things are getting off the tracks.


A Whoa there big fellow moment.



#1 – Identify The Problem





Houston, we've had a problem

- #1: Problem Identification
 - My Definition ≠ Your Definition
 - No Big Deal vs Very Big Deal
- IT (WPV) Didn't Just Materialize
 - Days, Weeks, Months, Years
- IT (WPV) is Real from the Employee's Prospective
- Outside Circumstances and Relationships Impact IT (WPV)
 - The Straw that Broke...

- 4/11/1970 @ 1:13pm CST Apollo 13 launch
- 4/13 @ 9:08pm "Houston we've had a problem"
- 4/17 @ 12:04pm Splash down
- The Problem Manifested itself on April 13, 1970
 BUT the Problem Existed LONG Before That!



What to look for — Potential **IT** (WPV) Tells What is The Key to Finding?

- Nobody Likes Me
- Disrespect of Authority
- Behavior Changes
- Performance Disruptions
- Crying-Sulking-Tantrums
- Pushing Limits What can I get away with today?
- Disregard for Personal Safety

- Inappropriate Statements or Actions
- Excessive Swearing
- Body Language *Space Invaders*
- Forgetfulness and Confusion
- Inability to Focus
- Blame Game
- Poor Personal Hygiene

I'll know IT when I see IT - But if you don't look for IT you will never see IT

Okay, we got a Problem, Now What? How do we Defuse a Ticking Bomb?

- Communication vs Confrontation
 - Correction-Stagnation-Deterioration
- Let's just calm down
 - That NEVER Works
- Half of Good Communication is Active Listening
 - Beyond the Words
 - Body Language (WE & THEY)
 - Tones Thundering Tearful
 - Look eye, always look eye




Conflict Resolution Basics

- Be Active: Look
- Manage Anger
 - THEY Might be 100% Wrong
 - THEY Might be 100% Right
 - Probably Between the Two
 - You Have to Control Your Anger
- Listen Actively
 - Don't Roll YOUR Eyes!
 - Focus on What THEY are Saying
 - Ask Questions
 - Body Language Yours & Theirs

- Avoid Assumptions
 - YOU can ask Questions
 - YOU can Repeat to THEM what YOU Understand THEM to Say
 - I Understand What YOU Are Saying
- Don't Add Fuel to the Fire
- Look for Common Ground
- Cautious With Criticism
- Avoid War Stories
- Deescalate the Situation


Two Very Different Possible Outcomes
